New Metroplex tenants

Building products manufacturer ARDEX Australia, along with pallet provider Loscam and fuel retailer Puma Energy, have signed agreements to move into the first stage of the \$350 million Wacol-based development, Metroplex South, being developed by GPT Group and local developer Metroplex. The new lease deals follow Volvo Group's announcement it will open its new Australian headquarters and dealership at Metroplex Westgate. GPT Head of Office and Logistics Matthew Faddy said Metroplex Westgate would consolidate Wacol's position as South East Queensland's key centre for manufacturing and logistics.
